Wednesday, 03 July 2024, 3.00-5.00 pm IST

Meant for: Principals/School Leaders

Session Title: *Principal Pioneers: Charting New Territories in Career Counseling for CBSE Schools*

Description: Designed for CBSE school principals, this workshop delves into the critical role of career counseling in the evolving education landscape. It addresses the dual impact of counseling: the immediate improvement in student learning outcomes and the long-term benefits such as enhanced well-being, readiness for employment, and a strengthened alumni network. The session will present strategies for systemic changes within school systems, guided by ethical frameworks. Participants will learn about integrating a comprehensive counseling program that aligns with the New Education Policy (NEP), aiming to create an educational environment where students excel academically and are well-prepared for their future careers. The workshop encourages collaboration among educators to transform schools into supportive ecosystems for holistic student development. This is an opportunity for educational leaders to contribute to a significant, positive change in education, ensuring students are equipped for the challenges and opportunities ahead.

Learning Outcomes:

The session aims at:

- Understanding the immediate and holistic impact of career counseling on multiple school systems and student learning outcomes
- Integration based on NEP — the role of career guidance in creating a holistic school of the future

Session Title: Transformative Teaching: Integrating Career Education in CBSE Curricula

Description: This workshop for CBSE school teachers explores educators' pivotal role in guiding students' career trajectories, capitalizing on their daily influence within the classroom setting. It emphasizes transforming spontaneous moments of inspiration into deliberate, structured guidance. Teachers will be introduced to straightforward, impactful strategies for incorporating career education into their curricula, thereby improving student engagement and achievement. Furthermore, the session aims to equip teachers with the skills to assist students in exploring their best-fit decisions, using their expertise in specific subjects as a catalyst for encouragement and direction. Another critical focus of the workshop is the concept of counseling as a collective responsibility among all school educators. This approach reinforces the idea that effective guidance and support for students' future paths is a shared duty, enhancing the school's educational environment through collaborative, intentional counseling practices.

Learning Outcomes

- Turning unintentional inspiration to intentional guidance — techniques to guide and inspire students to make informed decisions as a 10% counselor
- Simple career education integrations to enhance classroom learning and student outcomes

Session Title: Navigating Careers with Conscience: Rethinking Counseling in CBSE Schools

Description: This workshop for CBSE school counselors aims to transcend traditional "test and tell" counseling methods, which often confine students by offering them only psychometric assessments and single advice sessions in their final year of school. Instead, it promotes the development of self-reflection and decision-making skills from an early stage. The program emphasizes the essential role of counselors in guiding students toward careers that align with their capabilities and contribute positively to society. This is particularly vital in addressing current global issues and promoting sustainable growth. By highlighting the relationship between career choices and their social impact, the workshop prepares counselors to guide students in making career decisions that are not only purposeful but also enriching. This approach enhances students' sense of self-worth and fulfillment, positively contributing to their overall well-being and personal development. Through this comprehensive approach, the workshop aims to equip counselors with the necessary strategies to nurture a generation of informed, purpose-driven individuals.

Learning Outcomes

- Switching from a "test and tell" model to a student-empowered/self-directed counseling method — empowering students with a skill for life
- Moving towards purpose-driven career decision-making — guidance for opportunities to create positive social impact

Session Title: The Power of Choice: Empowering CBSE Parents for Informed Career Decisions
