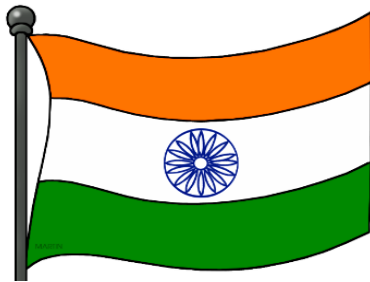

Aeroplane, Aeroplane

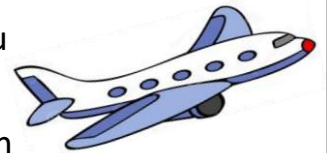
Up in the sky!
